Problem Statement: Each person must pass their tube to the next person sitting down, then pass their tube to the next person sitting up, and then pass to one person ahead standing up.

Approach: First, we came up with the idea of every other person facing outwards from the circle for the last sequence. Then, we first started out by trying out the first sequence of the challenge and failed many times. After a while, we figured it out and decided to practice the second and third sequences of the game. It took a while to figure out the later sequences because they were more difficult than the first sequence. The practice we did allowed us to be better prepared for the harder sequences of the game.

Solution: We did not win, however we did learn some things about passing the tube. We learned that the best technique of passing the tube is to throw it high in the air in order to provide your teammate a sufficient period of time to catch it.
