

Pringles Project

Steps

First make a box using shipping tape and cardboard

Dimensions for the box should be 4" by 4" base and 2.5" height

Leave the top of the box open so you can keep the pringle in there.

Get cotton pads and line them on the bottom of the box.

Then get cotton balls and shred them using your hands.

Line more cotton pads on the sides of the boxes. Once that is done put some shredded cotton balls on top of the pad layer.

Steps

Then place the pringle chip in the box.

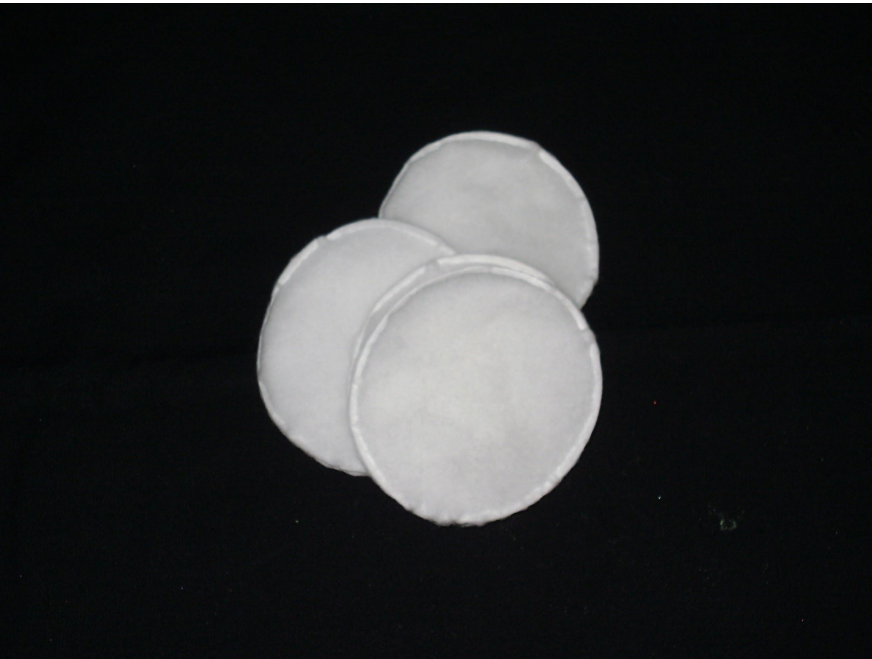
Once placed add more shredded cotton over it until the box is full of shredded cotton.

Put the top of the box on and tape the whole outside.

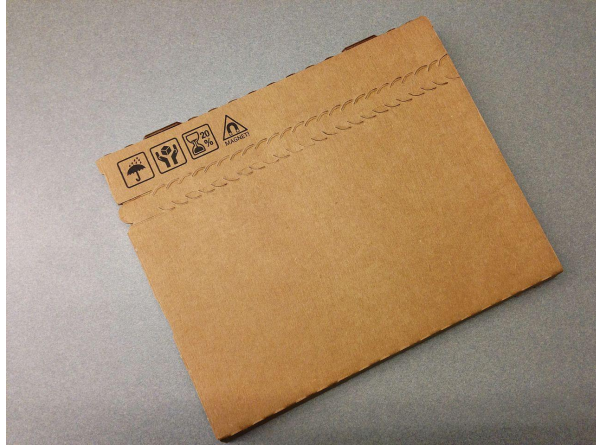
If you want more protection, take more cotton pads or shredded cotton and put them on the outside of the box and put tape on it.

Materials

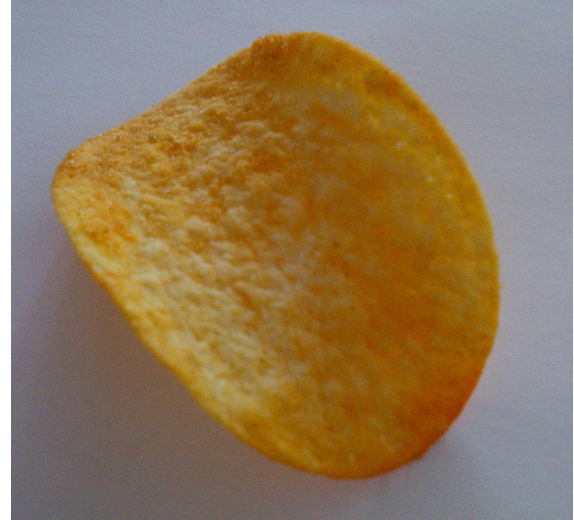
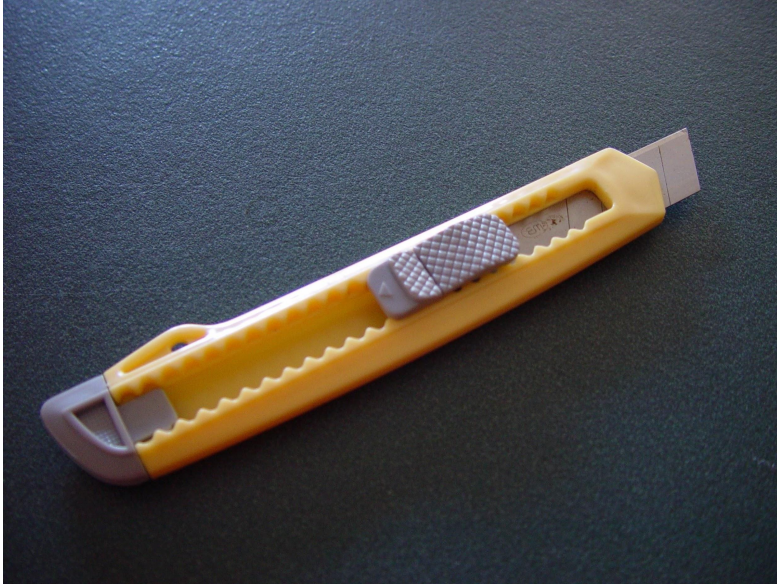
Cotton pad and cotton balls



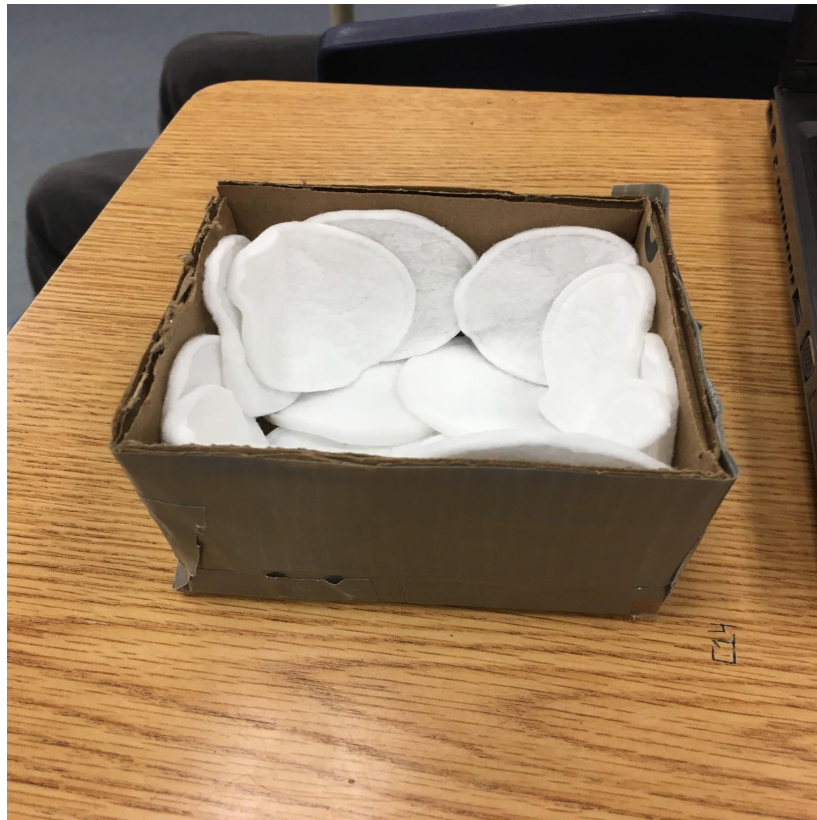
Cardboard and shipping tape



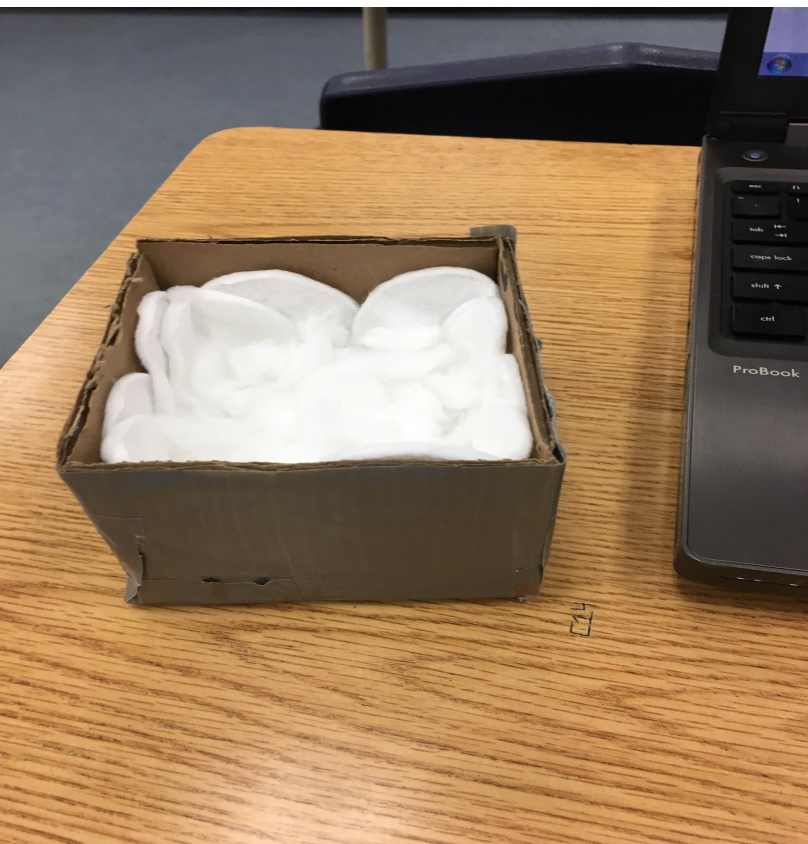
Box cutter and pringle chip



Step one and two



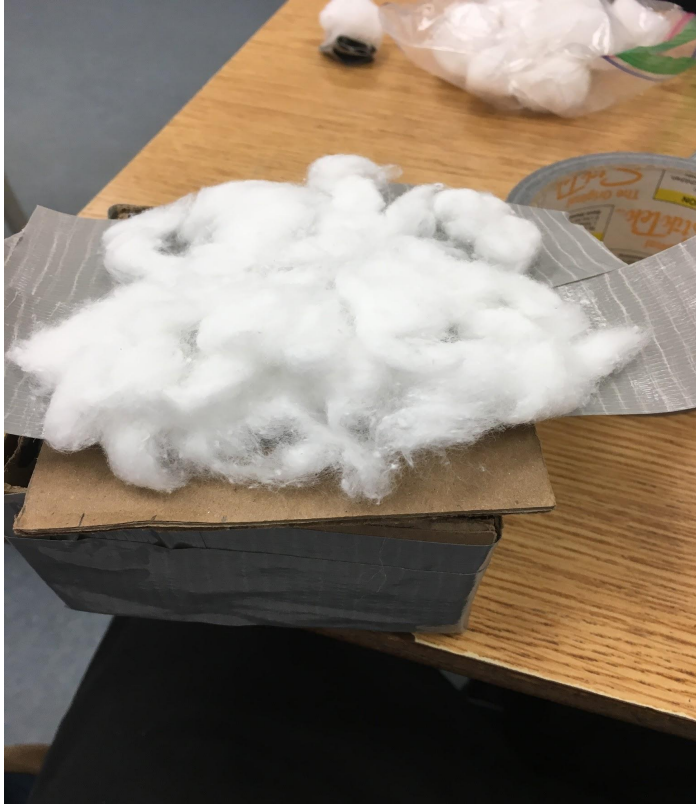
Step 3 and 4

Dimensions

Box- 4 by 4 by 2.5 inches

Final product with duct tape only- $4\frac{1}{4}$ by $4\frac{1}{4}$ by $2\frac{3}{4}$ inches

If you decide to do the optional steps- $5\frac{1}{4}$ by $5\frac{1}{4}$ by $3\frac{3}{4}$ inches

Weight with only duct tape- 61 grams

Weight if you use optional steps- 94 grams

P.S.

Use shipping tape and not duct tape. We used duct tape because we did not have shipping tape. Duct tape is not allowed for shipping

Put proper stamp and shipping address label on the box after done with the steps.
